- 1. The meeting was called to order by President D. Ellwood at 1515H
- 2. Secretary General confirmed a quorum, i.e. 11 countries are represented (50% of total 22 members)
- 3. Treasurer's report was given by Satoshi Kusuda noting:
 - a. Financial report approved by Council and audited by President D. Ellwood
 - b. Countries who have not paid their membership dues.
- 4. Secretary's report:
 - a. Updated master list of country perinatal society presidents
 - b. Re-established contact with old and new society presidents for more active participation
 - c. Regular web-site updates
 - d. Proposed re-designing of website

- e. Facilitated mid-term FAOPS council meeting/discussion via Skype call in April 2013
- f. Chaired the FAOPS symposium in the World Congress of Perinatal Medicine for Developing Countries, held in September 2014 in Cancun Mexico
- g. Initiated discussion on amendments to the Constitution for approval of the General Assembly:
 - ✓ Add objective in Article 2 of the Constitution, wherein FAOPS supports each perinatal society's guideline in ethical practice of Perinatology
 - ✓ Member countries may have more than one society involved in perinatology to join the FAOPS
 - ✓ Process of bidding for the FAOPS congress has been defined, acceptance of bids is 2 congresses or 4 years ahead of schedule. Next bidding will be done in 2016 for the congress scheduled in 2020
 - ✓ Amnesty granted for unpaid membership dues of countries beginning 2013
