History Ultrasound Society of Pakistan By

In 1988, a congress in ultrasound was arranged in Islamabad by the group of Radiologist , Gynaecologist, Sonologist, Cardiologist and Physicians.

During the congress it was suggested that a common platform should be available to discuss this new emerging modality hence a society should be formed.

The keen interest was taken by the group from Islamabad represented by Prof Saad Rana and Brigadeir MB Zafar and from Karachi by Dr Shahida Zaidi and Dr Musarrat Hasan. Ad hock committee was made and it was decided to hold the first election after the Bali AFSUMB congress in 1989.

During this period two groups from Islamabad and Karachi developed difference on many issues hence parted ways and made separate societies with the same name but at the same time both applied for affiliation to AFSUMB.

Since AFSUMB could affiliate only one society from each country hence the matter was deferred in the Executive Council Meeting of AFSUMB at Bali congress1989.

Dr Musarrat Hasan realizing that the matter is not settling one way or the other submitted an application to withdraw the affiliation application. Since other society was not active for 9 years hence Dr Musarrat Hasan was finally asked to submit a fresh application for affiliation in 1998 at Taipei Taiwan which was accepted and the USP got its final affiliation in Kaula Lumpur at the council Meeting held in 1999.

Our Society got registered in 1990 at corporate Law Authority Govt of Pakistan.Dr Shahida Zaidi became the first President and Dr Musarrat Hasan the First Secretary General and Dr Farooq Bhurya the first Treasurer of Ultrasound Society of Pakistan. The first News letter of USP was published in May 1990 and their on the society has been growing with members increasing every year. Many National & International conferences and Seminars, workshop clinical meeting have been arranged under the banner of USP. The activities of the society rotated to different cities of Pakistan so that everyone could benefit from it.

1st Clinical Meeting
THE 1st clinical meeting of Ultrasound Society of Pakistan was hosted by Dr. Musarrat Hasan at Pearl Continental on 9th August1990 . The meeting was followed by

lunch given by M/S Qualitron.
INSPITE of inciement weather quite a large number of doctors attended the meeting.
The meeting started with the recitation of Holy Quran by Dr. Mohammad Hashim. DR. MUSARRAT HASAN showed recording of interesting cases with the help of video projector on abdominal,small parts, I doppler duplex, obstetrical & gynaecological ultrasound.

HE showed comparative study of 3.5 and 5.0 MHz, transducers in gynaecological and obstetrical cases. The efficacy and accuracy of doppler duplex scaning in OB/GYN and abdominal cases was highlighted.

Invasive procedures like biopsies and aspiration with the help of puncture adapter were also shown. Small parts scanning included cases on Breast, Thyroid, Testicles and Neonatal brain.

IT was concluded that high resolution machines, various frequencies transduc-ers and additional gadgets certainly im prove the quality of image which ultimately helps in the diagnosis. He encouraged the partici-pants to record their cases on VCR so as to present them in other clinical meetings. FILM on color doppler was shown to update the participants on the latest technology. MEMBERS were informed that such clinical meetings will also be held in other cities of Pakistan where there are atleast ten members of the society .

2ND ONE-DAY SEMINAR 15TH MAY, 1992

The second one-day seminar on Color Doppler was held on 15th May, 1992 at Hotel Pearl Continental, Karachi in collaboration with Institute of Ultrasound Imaging.

The Executive Council meeting conveyed at 8.30 am.

The meeting was followed by a video film on obstetrical standards in ultrasound.

Seminar formally started with recitation of Holy Quran by Dr. M. Saulat Nawaz.

Dr. Musarrat Hasan, Secretary General, Ultrasound Society of Pakistan, welcoming the chief guest, Prof. Ali Mohammad Ansari and other distinguished guests gave a brief resume of activities of the Society. He also emphasized the importance of ultrasonography, specially color doppler ultrasound, in the diagnosis and management of various diseases.

Prof. Ali Mohammad Ansari speaking on the occasion thanked the organisers for inviting him. He highlighted the importance of ultrasonography in recent medical practices and predicted that in the near future doctors will utilize diagnostic ultrasound before recommending any invasive procedure.

Dr. M. Farooq Bhurya gave a lecture on the principle of color doppler ultrasound with special reference to peripheral vasculature.

Dr. Musarrat Hasan talked in detail about the applications of color doppler in OBS/GYN, abdominal, neonatal and cardiac cases,

Prof. Z.K. Kazi in his concluding remarks appreciated the efforts made by Dr. Musarrat Hasan and his committee for organising such an enlightening and informative seminar.

After lunch, the afternoon session began with the General Body meeting of Ultrasound Society of Pakislan. This was followed by live demonstration on patients, carried out by Dr. Musarrat Hasan on Toshiba 270-A.

HIGHLIGHTS OF THE CLINICAL MEETING OF USP HELD IN KARACHI ON 12^{71} SEPT, 2004

A clinical meeting of the Ultrasound Society of Pakistan was held at Pearl Continental Hotel, Karachi on 12th September 2004 from 9.00 am to 3.00 pm. It started with prerecorded recitation of Holy Quran by Dr M Saulat Nawaz (Past President of USP) who could not attend the meeting due to his ailment.

Dr Musarrat Hasan was the heart of the Clinical meeting. He grasped the audience attention by his impressive way of teaching, not only by showing interesting cases but also showed different video clips of his personal experience which served as a refreshing glass of juice after strenuous exercise. He covered all the important topics concerning Obstetrical, Gynecological, Abdominal and peripheral ultrasound.

The meeting was divided in three sessions. Every session of teaching was followed by video clips and refreshments in the form of tea and lunch. Dr Hasan also offered certain refreshments to those participants giving right answer in between the teaching session to involve them and to give them more incentive.

Following are some cases which were showed during the teaching session - He showed various typical and atypical cases of dermoids which really enthralled the audience. - He highlighted new concept of diagnosing Polycystic Ovaries i.e. the volume of the ovary should be more than 12 ml there should be more than five follicles at the periphery and echogenic central stoma. It was emphasized that repeat scan after 48 hours showing no change in above parameters will make diagnosis of PCO.

- He showed various cases of Chromosomal abnormalities e.g. echogenic bowels which he compared with limbs echogenicity, Distended Urinary bladder in 1st trimester, typical angle of iliac wings, prominent ear, enlarged tongue. He highlighted and emphasized the imaging of nasal bone measurement from 14 weeks onwards. He told that absence or hypo-plastic nasal bone is suggestive of underlying chromosomal abnormality. He also told the difference between umblical cord cyst and wartons jelly.
- In Cervix he highlighted cervical incompetence, stenosis and measurements.
 He showed Hypophosphatasia which is marked demineralization of bones, Cleft lip.

He presented slickes about incidence of accards infestation in Pakistanilando-Pakistani subcontinentwhele world and also showed pictures of worms in G.B. and C.B.D. Besides the Clinical presentation he described the use of different diagnostic modalties in the assessment of patients with ascariasis and also elaborated

Dr. Mohammad Wahaj showed video film of interesting cases which included Hydatid cyst of liver. Huge ovarian mass, Normal foetal heart and vessels, Anterior abdominal wall abscess, ureteric stone and ureteric jet. The most interesting case was normal intrauterine pregnancy resem-bling an Ectopic gestation. Besided case reports he also showed film of water hag technique for visualization of superficial tissues and scanning of thyroid and internal carotid artonics with a 3.5 MHz transducer.

At the end of scientific session Dr. Mussarat Hassan the Secretary General of U.S.P. who came from Karachi presented very interesting cases on overhead Projector. These included Hydatidiform mole with emphasis on significance of doppler study in such patients. Besides this, cases of uretero coele, hydroureter and its differential diagnosis was also discussed. This session was followed by a short period of question and


