The AFSUMB Young Investigator's Award is presented to three authors of outstanding papers. Three prizes will be awarded: one Grand Prize, and two-Gold Prizes and Honorable Mention Awards will be awarded for one, two and three authors, respectively.

- Grand Prize: USD 1,000

- Gold Prize: USD 500

This new Young Investigator Award will start to be presented from AFSUMB2026, Vietnam.a
