AFSUMB is the second largest ultrasound federation under the WFUMB family. The federation represents over 19,670 physicians, scientists, engineers, technologists and sonographers in Asia. One of the AFSUMB's goals is to provide resources for ultrasound education programs in developing and emerging countries, to promote the technical development and ultrasonography knowledge. The another important ultrasound event is that Chinese Taipei Society of Ultrasound in Medicine has organized the 16th WFUMB Congress (WFUMB 2017 TAIPEI) which was successfully conducted from Oct 13 to Oct 17, 2017, at the Taipei International Conference Center, Taipei, Taiwan. The Co-Presidents of the congress was Professor Cheng-Wen Chiang and Professor Harvey Nisebbaum.

The congress was joined together with the 9th Asian Conference on Ultrasound Contrast Imaging (ACUCI) and Global Chinese Ultrasound Forum. World leaders in the field of medical ultrasonography delivered lectures on the latest development in ultrasound. In summary, there were 2,452 attendees (including 704 international participants) from 46 countries, and 406 invited speakers from 35 countries. The scientific program consisted of 541 invited speeches, 261 oral presentations and 223 posters. The presentations were classified into 21 Tracks according to different subspecialties. The organizing committee offered 3 kinds of awards to the winners of the oral and poster presentations. At the congress, At the congress, Professor Nisenbaum and Prof essor Nolsøe organized a WFUMB Education Program, addressing the global status of ultrasound education in medical schools.

During the congress, the Administrative Council Meeting of the 13th AFSUMB was held on October 14, 2017. It was decided that the Congress of AFSUMB 2020 will be held at Beijing, China.

BSU is now preparing for its 30th National Conference on 22 September 2017.

The 19th WFUMB Center of Excellence Workshop of the World Federation for Ultrasound in Medicine and Biology was held on 3 March 2017 at the National Institute of Nuclear Medicine and Allied Science, Shahbagh, Dhaka. The topic of the workshop was 'Controversies in pregnancy ultrasound'. Total 110 participants joined. Prof. Byung Ihn Choi and Prof. Kanu Bala were the WFUMB Faculty. Prof. Choi monitored the whole preparation. The 20th WFUMB COE Workshop will be held on 2 March 2018 in the City of Dhaka.

The PSUCMI continues to exert efforts at building a competent, ethical and active membership that our societies can be proud of. We attended the AFSUMB AC Meeting and WFUMB 2017 at Taipei TICC in October 13-17, 2017. We are also preparing our annual convention of year 2018.

Annual Convention

March 17-18, 2017– On March 17-18, 2017, we conducted the 15th PSUCMI Annual Convention with the theme "Enhancing Skills and Competency in Ultrasound and Advancing Technology" at the

Ballroom of the New World Manila Bay Hotel. The scientific program focused more on interventional ultrasound, highlighting the role of Doppler Ultrasound in the diagnosis of Tumors, the role of Intra-operative Ultrasound in Difficult Cholecystectomies, Ultrasound-guided Regional Nerve Block . On this occasion, we invited one of our local members, a Gynecologic Oncologist, Obstetrician-Gynecologist and Sonologist with exposure to the concept of High Frequency Focused Ultrasound.

Among our foreign lecturers we invited Dr. Jae Young Lee, (Past AFSUMB Secretary) to share with us his experience as he introduced to us the application of HIFU in medical practice. We also exerted efforts to solicit the participation of SNS Enterprises, Incorporated, the country distributor of the High Frequency Ultrasound Machines from Shenzen, China to provide information, photos and videos on their existing installations, if only to prove to our members that the technology is real and is available. The convention was attended by 188 of 210 Members. A smaller select group of 37 members also registered for a Master's Course on Hepatobiliary Ultrasound, MSK Ultrasound, OBGYN Ultrasound during which the registrants learned "hands on ultrasound scanning" supervised by Drs. Musarrat Hasan (Pakistan), Jae Young Lee (South Korea), Jose Antonio Bouffard (Detroit, USA) and Chander Lulla (India).

Last October, 2017, a PSUCMI delegation registered for the WFUMB Congress in Taipei, Taiwan. Dr. Rodney Fernan (Radiology, PSUCMI Immediate Past President) served as a Session Moderator. One of our younger members, Dr. Lesley Barba presented a research paper on a Proposed Normogram for the Humerus derived from Filipino Patients. She was accompanied by her Research Adviser, Dr. Amaryllis Digna Yazon (OBGYN Sonologist and Specialist in High Risk Pregnancies). On 19-20th August 2017, the Society holded its 15th Annual Seminar. The theme is on "no pain, no gain" focusing on the role of ultrasound in diagnosis and management of a wide range of painful conditions, as well the use of ultrasound as an adjunct to anaesthetic procedures.

Prior to the Seminar, a half-day program on Doppler ultrasound workshop is organized. This workshop includes hands-on training at five different stations focusing on different organ systems.

In 2016, the Society started the challenge shield for institutions / clinics to present their research. The shield is awarded to the best team based on a number of criteria with judging performed by neutral parties (usually invited speakers).

Annual Congress Report:

- MUST have the scientific meeting twice a year (usually be February and August September) which sometime the congresses are organized in hands-on workshop.
- Two different targets are 1) Special topics for radiologists/obstetric and gynecologists and 2) Basic US knowledge for general physician.
- Around 8-12 ultrasound companies being sponsors for the conference every time and tend to increase in number recently.
- ➤ The participants are usually around 200-300 person in each conferences. Almost are physicians, both graduated and under-graduated (mostly are radiology residents and fellows). More less are radiographers.
- > Speakers are usually local but sometime the international speakers are invited.
- We had organized 2 AFSUMB Thailand workshops, the first one was around 2006 and the 2nd just was held during 7-9th November, 2016 in Bangkok.
- Thailand was the host of 1st AFSUMB meeting during 12-16th November 2007.

♦ 2014 Convention:

The Society organized the ultrasound workshop "*Ultrasound in the clinical practice for the beginners*" during 8-9 November 2014. The course contained both lectures and handson sessions. The total of 257 participants joined this workshop, most were the general practitional doctors.

♦ 2015 Convention:

- ✓ The 2015 convention was held during 12-13 February 2015, with the theme: "*Ultrasound of the small parts*". The total of 355 participants, including the members and residency doctors, joined the convention.
- ✓ The second convention was held during 6-7 August 2015, with the theme: "Pediatric ultrasound and Ultrasound elastography". The course included lecture sessions and elastography hands-on workshop. The total of 215 participants joined the convention.

♦ 2016 Convention:

- ✓ The first convention was held during 11-12 February 2016, with the theme: "Ultrasound technology and technique" and "Obstetric ultrasound workshop".

 The total participants, were around 250 doctors. Prof Jiro Hata, Professor, Dept. of Clinical Pathology and Laboratory Medicine, Kayassaki Medical School, was an invited.
 - Clinical Pathology and Laboratory Medicine, Kawasaki Medical School, was an invited speakers for many topics
- ✓ The second convention was held during 25-26 September 2016, with the theme: "Color Doppler Sonography in Routine Practice". The course included lecture sessions and small group Doppler hands-on workshop (renal, carotid, deep vein). The total around 240 participants joined the convention.
- There also were outsided lecture and hands-on small group teaching for 4 times (2 were basic US in abdomen and 2 were basic US in OB-GYN) held each quarter in 2016 organized by MUST and GE US company. The theme were "US in clinical practice for the beginners" who were almost GP physicians in each part of the country eg. northern, east-north and southern. Around 50 doctors from the rural areas joined the conference.

♦ 2017 Convention:

- ✓ The first convention this year was held during 23-24 February 2017, with the theme: "*The Mass: From Head to Toe*". The total around 220 participants, including the members and residency as well as fellowship training in Radiology, joined the convention.
- The second convention will be held during 24-25 August 2017, with the theme: "Doppler Ultrasound: From Head to Toe". The course included lecture sessions and also hands-on workshop which is organized due to many requests from the attendance who did not get hands-on learning last year.
- There are outsided lecture and hands-on small group teaching for 4 times (3 are basic US in abdomen and 1 is basic US in OB-GYN) held each quarter this year organized by MUST and GE US company (3 times) and once with CMC Toshiba US company. The theme were "US in clinical practice" with around 50 participants joined and fell that the conferences are very useful for their daily clinical work where their hospitals have no available radiologist stand-by.

1. AFSUMB Congresses:

9th AFSUMB Congress 2010 in New Delhi, India.

- AFSUMB organized the Bienniel Congress in New Delhi, India, NOVEMBER 18-21, 2010.
- The 9th conference of AFSUMB was held at Hotel Ashok in New Delhi, Indian Federation of Ultrasound in Medicine and Biology (IFUMB) was the host of the conference. First day of the congress was devoted to concurrent hands-on workshops held at three venues and covered 18 subjects of interest to practicing sonographer. Three days of main conference covered abdominal ultrasound, ob-gyn ultrasound, vascular, small parts, echocardiography, contrast agents and newer modalities and recent advances in the field of ultrasound. Conference had galaxy of 29 eminent speakers from AFSUMB, EFSUMB, WFUMB, ASUM, USA and Middle East apart from 80 eminent speakers from India and neighbouring countries. Conference was attended by 123 foreign delegates and 1050 Indian delegates, who were enriched with the advances in the current practice of ultrasound in their area of interest.

- The first day of the congress was devoted to four concurrent workshops held in three different hospitals. The vascular workshop was held in the University Hospital Kuala Lumpur, the Obstetric Doppler workshop and the Urogynecology workshop was held in the Maternity Hospital Kuala Lumpur while the Gynaecology workshop was held in the Ampang Hospital, Selangor. The Journal of Medical Ultrasound (JMU) has published 6 issues since May 2016 when AFSUMB Congress was held at Kyoto, Japan. There were 19 original articals and 6 review articles contributed from Bangladesh (2), Brazil (1), Canada (1), China (2), Egypt (3), India (1) Ireland (2), Italy (1), Japan (3), Singapore (1), South Africa (1), Spain (1), USA (3), and the rest were from Taiwan. More manuscripts are under reviewing, but we are still short of the submit articles. We urgently need the members of AFSUMB to contribute their researches or interesting clinical cases in our journal.

Elsevier, the publisher of our journal is going to withdraw their publication business from Taiwan Market in next year (2018). Thus, the issuing affairs of JMU will be transferred to another publisher – Wolters Kluwer Health/Medknow. We are dealing the contract now, and the publishing process has been proceeded. It is a good news that since this year, JMU has abstracted/indexed by EMBASE, SIIC Data Bases, ScienceDirect, Scopus, Directory of Open Access Journals (DOAJ) and Emerging Sources Citation Index (ESCI). JMU also has passed the Scientific Quality Review by NLM for Pubmed Central (PMC) this April.
