# 《 Introduction of Sakae Ward, City of Yokohama 》

#### 1. Overview of the City of Yokohama and Sakae Ward

The City of Yokohama is located 30 kilometers west of Tokyo, and with a population of 3.67million, is the second largest city in Japan after Tokyo. Yokohama developed as a port city after the end of the seclusion policy of the Edo period, and last year marked the 150<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the opening of its port.




As for the environment, Sakae Ward is covered with trees and fields, and the ratio of forests is twice that of the average of Yokohama. From Sakae Ward's experience with river flooding, local community cooperation against natural disasters, including flooding, is very active. Recently, this cooperation has extended into the field of crime prevention and plays an important role there.

Sakae Ward is becoming an aging society relatively rapidly among the wards of Yokohama.

The figure on the right shows the trend of the aging rate. (percentage of citizens 65 years and older )

In a survey of the citizens' image of the ward, a positive point was 'helping each other in the neighborhood', and a negative one was 'inconvenience of the traffic network' The number of medical facilities is the fewest in Yokohama, and there is only one general hospital.



## 2. History of safety promotion based on the concept of SC

**2005 April** — Established a project based on a local officer's proposal: "Let's make Yokohama a Safe Community City"

**October** — Attended the 14<sup>th</sup> international Safe Community Congress with the announcement of a poster session in Bergen, Norway..

**December**—Held a 'Safety Promotion' seminar for local officers (General Remarks by Dr. Sorimachi, Traffic Safety by Mr. Ishizuki. Child Safety by Mr. Ohtsubo, Suicide Prevention by Dr. Kawanishi)

2007 September-Held a seminar by Prof. Leif Svanstrom for local officers in Yokohama

2008 March — Attended the international Conference on Safe Communities with a presentation in Kameoka City, Kyoto.

**2009 April** — Sakae Ward's General Affairs Division established a new position in charge of Safe Community.

June — Made an announcement to start a Safe Community project in Sakae Ward Administration Management Policy.

**September**—Did a feature on Safe Community in Sakae's version of the City of Yokohama official bulletin.

October —Attended the 3<sup>rd</sup> Japan Safe Community Congress with a presentation and an international symposium (the designation ceremony of Towada City, Aomori Prefecture)

**2010 February**—Establish the Safe Community project in Sakae Ward's 'Community Planning Action Plan' (2010~2015) and the goal of designation in 2012

-Held a seminar by Dr. Sorimachi 'Child rights from the perspective of Safety Promotion' for the citizens of Sakae Ward.

March —Attended the 19<sup>th</sup> International Safe Community Congress with a presentation.

# 4. Sakae Ward (Yokohama) Chart of Causes of Death (2008)

The total number of deaths in Sakae Ward in 2008 was 856. For causes of death, accidents rank  $5^{\rm th}$  and suicides  $6^{\rm th}$ . This order has not changed since 1999, and is the same in Yokohama and Japan as well.






(1) Total number of deaths by age group in the last five years in the City of Yokohama



# (2) Total number of deaths by age group in the last five years in the City of Yokohama




## (3) Total number of deaths by age group in the last five years in Sakae Ward






# (1) Causes of death by age group in Sakae Ward




## (2) Injuries related to ambulances in Sakae, 2008

① Frequency and Severity (total number: 1178 persons)







## 2 Severity by Case of injuries
